

NORTH AMERICAN INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM (NAICS)

The following chart shows 2023 incidence rates of nonfatal occupational injuries and illness by industry. The Days Away, Restricted or Transferred (DART) rate includes days away from work, job transfer or restriction. The Cases with Days Away from Work (CDAW) rate includes cases involving days away from work but does not include restricted activity.

In order to qualify for a safety award, your incidence rate must be equal to or less than the incidence rate listed for your NAICS code. Utilize 3-digit NAICS code, if one is not listed then use the appropriate 2-digit NAICS code.

Note: The rates listed below are 50 percent of the incidence rate for each NAICS code.
