- III. Service and Testing Tom Chambers, Bureau Chief
  - a. Maintenance by elevator companies needs to be addressed as it is lacking majorly across the board. Workload vs manpower seems to be a key factor from what we have seen and heard.
    - Solution suggestion: hire the people to do the work and reduce the workload in order to provide the service that elevator companies are responsible for.
  - b. The Bureau will be removing units from operation for past due testing and lack of maintenance.
- IV. New Content and Miscellaneous
  - Mods and Alterations pay attention to detail such as wiring, cleaning, properly secured equipment. Do it the right way, no short cuts. Don't be in a hurry to get it done, do it right the first time.
  - b. Be aware of Kone 110 Escalator bulletin on shock hazard from automatic oiler.
  - c. Please provide NCDOL with internal bulletins as well we need to know.
  - d. Software changes require permits from NCDOL.
  - e. LULA installs need a letter provided from local building AHJ/building inspector.
  - f. Reference ASME A17.1 *Appendix L Index for Alterations* when there are question or concerns regarding alterations. This is an index for anything considered to be an alteration.
  - g. Wireless Communications are becoming more popular, however are falling short of meeting code. Please check when proposing wireless communications that the system meets all aspects for compliance with 2.27.1
