On 20 June 1990, Federal OSHA promulgated technical amendments to the General Industry Standards at 55 FR 25093 that the 11 April 1990 "Redesignation and Other Non-Substantive Revisions" made to the Welding, Cutting and Brazing standards at 55 FR 13694. Three (3) references to the general industry welding, cutting and brazing standards, which are found in the general industry standards, were not corrected in the 11 April 1990 final rule. This action serves to amend those references so they refer to the proper provisions of the revised OSHA general industry welding, cutting and brazing standards. The references are:
