Field Information System Part I Occupational Exposure to Cadmium; Final Rule; Correction and Amendment

DISCUSSION:

When Federal OSHA promulgated their final rule on occupational exposure to cadmium in the **Federal Register** (57 FR 42101, September 14, 1992), the standard for the agricultural industries was inadvertently omitted. In addition, this new final rule mistakenly deleted the qualitative fit test protocol using aerosol saccharin solution.

On April 23, 1993, OSHA amended the cadmium final rule to include the standard for agricultural industries (29 CFR 1928.1027) and to rectify a technical error by reinstating the aerosol saccharin respirator qualitative fit test protocol at Parts 1910 (General Industry) and 1915 (Maritime). In addition, the amendment corrects some obvious typographical errors that were present in the original publication of the cadmium final rule for Parts 1910, 1915, and 1926 (Construction).

ACTION:

This correction and amendment to the cadmium final rule were adopted verbatim in North Carolina by Commissioner of Labor on September 24, 1993 with an effective date of the same. A copy of the complete text from the <u>Federal Register</u> announcement (Vol. 58, No. 77) is attached. Please file this NC CFR Revision in Part I of your Field Information System.
