Final Rule: Corrections

DISCUSSION:

On June 30, 1993, (58 FR 35076), OSHA promulgated a final rule to incorporate the text of the Safety and Health Standards for General Industry (29 CFR 1910) which had been identified as applicable to construction work into the Safety and Health Standards for Construction (29 CFR 1926). On August 12, 1996, (61 FR 41738), OSHA issued an amendment to delete the text that was incorporated from §§1910.333 and 1910.334 (Subpart S-Electrical) into paragraphs (a)(4), (f) and (g) of §§1926.416 and paragraph (d) of §§1926.417 (Subpart K-Electrical). This action was taken because the preamble to the final rule on Electrical Safety-Related Work Practices (55 FR 31984, August 6, 1990) clearly states that the provisions in question do not apply to construction employment.

ACTION:

The June 30, 1993, (58 FR 35076) final rule was adopted verbatim in North Carolina with an effective date of December 1, 1993. It was subsequently distributed for inclusion in the Field Information System (FIS) as CFR Revision 122. The August 12, 1996, (61 FR 41738) amendment was adopted verbatim in North Carolina by the Commissioner of Labor with an effective date of February 11, 1997. The applicable portion of the August 12, 1996, [Federal Register](#) (61 FR 41738), which includes the regulatory text of the amended standards, is attached. Copies of the associated amendments to the *NC Administrative Code* are available upon request.
