DISCUSSION:

On March 19, 1993, Federal OSHA promulgated a correction to Subpart H, Hazardous Materials, of the General Industry standards. This correction is to 29 CFR 1910.110 - Storage and Handling of Liquefied Petroleum Gases.

On March 29, 1993, Federal OSHA promulgated a correction to Subpart H, Hazardous Materials, of the General Industry standards. This correction is to 29 CFR 1910.109 - Explosives and Blasting Agents.

ACTION:

The corrections to 29 CFR 1910, Subpart H were adopted verbatim in North Carolina by the Commissioner of Labor with an effective date of December 31, 1993. Copies of the regulatory text from the **Federal Register** announcements ([Vol. 58, No. 52](#) and [Vol. 58, No. 58](#)) are attached.
