Storing and Handling of Liquefied Petroleum Gases, 29 CFR 1910.110

Final Rule, Corrections and Revisions

DISCUSSION:

On June 18, 1998, federal OSHA promulgated a final rule that corrected or eliminated provisions from various standards (63 FR 33449-33469). These changes were made to correct out of date, duplicative, unnecessary, or inconsistent standards.

One of the changes concerns storing and handling liquefied petroleum gases (Ref: 29 CFR 1910.110). Paragraphs (b)(15)(vi)-(viii) are deleted because these provisions fall under the jurisdiction of DOT regulations. In addition, paragraph (b)(15)(ix) is renumbered to new paragraph (b)(15)(vi).

ACTION:

The June 18, 1998, corrections and revisions ([63 FR 33449-33469](#)) were adopted verbatim with an effective date of October 8, 1998. The applicable portions of the referenced *Federal Register* are attached.
