DISCUSSION:

On April 6, 1994, federal OSHA promulgated additions and revisions to the occupational safety and health standards for General Industry. The revised federal standard, Subpart I - Personal Protective Equipment for General Industry, becomes effective July 5, 1994.

ACTION:

This final rule at 29 CFR 1910 Subpart I was adopted verbatim in North Carolina by the Commissioner of Labor with an effective date of September 1, 1994. A copy of the regulatory text from the <u>Federal Register</u> announcement (Vol. 59, No. 66) is attached. The final rule adds paragraphs (d), (e), and (f) to 1910.132, revises 1910.133, 1910.135 and 1910.136, adds 1910.138 - *Hazards to Hands*, and adds non-mandatory Appendices A & B to Subpart I.
