Chapter 7 Subchapter 7F Field Information System Air Contaminants Subpart Z -- Toxic and Hazardous Substances 29 CFR 1910.1000 PEL Corrections CFR Revision 145A CFR II

DISCUSSION:

On August 4, 1997, federal OSHA issued corrections to Tables Z-1 and Z-3 of 29 CFR 1910.1000 (<u>62 FR 42018</u>). The following table summarizes the federal changes and OSHNC's actions relative to each change.

Federal OSHA Change	OSHNC Action
Add an "x" in the skin designation column for "Cyanides (as CN)."	Adopted verbatim.
Revise the acronym for 1,2-Dibromo-3- chloropropane to read "(DBCP)"	No action required. T13 NCAC 07F.0101 already contains the correct acronym.
Remove the entries for Endosulfan and Perlite because they are carryovers from the 1989 Air Contaminants standards that were subsequently vacated at the federal level.	No action required. Except as specifically excepted in T13 NCAC 07F.0101, OSHNC had previously adopted the 1989 Air Contaminant standards as state-specific standards; therefore, these substances are not being removed from the T13 NCAC 07F.0101 PEL Tables.
Insert correct spelling "Trinitrophenol"	Adopted verbatim.
Revise the "Uranium (as U), Insoluble compounds" entry to read "0.25 mg/m3".	No action required. Except as specifically excepted in T13 NCAC 07F.0101, OSHNC had previously adopted the 1989 Air Contaminant standards as state-specific standards; therefore, the subject entry in the T13 NCAC 07F.0101 table will continue to read "0.2 mg/m3 TWA and 0.6 mg/m3 STEL."
Revise the mg/m3 Table Z-3 entry for "Coal Dust: Respirable fraction less than 5% SiO2" to read "2.4 mg/m3."	Adopted verbatim.
