**Final Rule, Corrections and Revisions**

**DISCUSSION:**

On June 18, 1998, federal OSHA promulgated a final rule that corrected or eliminated provisions from various standards ([63 FR 33449-33469](#)). These changes were made to correct out of date, duplicative, unnecessary, or inconsistent standards.

One of the changes concerns requirements for the textile industry (Ref: 29 CFR 1910.262). Paragraphs (c)(3), (c)(4), (gg), (ll)(1), (qq)(1), (qq)(2), and (rr) are removed because they reference general occupational safety and health standards that are applicable to this industry.

**ACTION:**

The June 18, 1998, corrections and revisions (63 FR 33449-33469) were adopted verbatim with an effective date of October 8, 1998. The applicable portions of the referenced *Federal Register* are attached.
