Final Rule

DISCUSSION:

On April 8, 1998, OSHA issued a final rule announcing that the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has extended its approval for a number of information collection requirements in OSHA's health standards. This final rule codified the OMB approval numbers and announced the effective dates of these approvals.

ACTION:

The April 8, 1998, OMB approvals were adopted verbatim with an effective date of October 8, 1998 and affect the following standards: noise (29 CFR 1910.95); asbestos in construction (29 CFR 1926.1101); access to employee exposure and medical records (29 CFR 1910.1020); formaldehyde (29 CFR 1910.1048); lead in general industry (29 CFR 1910.1025); bloodborne pathogens (29 CFR 1910.1030); ionizing radiation (29 CFR 1910.1096); lead in construction (29 CFR 1926.62); and asbestos in general industry (29 CFR 1910.1001).
