### **Final Rule**

### A. **Discussion**.

On February 18, 2020, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) published a final rule correcting typographical errors, including extraneous or omitted materials and inaccurate graphics, in 27 OSHA standards and regulations and makes no substantive changes or changes to the coverage of the affected standards. This rule revises standards in recordkeeping, construction, general industry, shipyard employment, and longshoring.

### B. <u>Action</u>.

The N.C. Commissioner of Labor adopted this rule with an effective date of September 23, 2020. Reference the <u>February 18, 2020 *Federal Register* (Volume 85, No. 32)</u> for the details related to these requirements.
