Re: Safety Memo

It has come to our attention that NCDOL Elevator inspectors are working with adjusters, mechanics and helpers from different elevator companies that are not wearing masks. As per the Governor's order, if you cannot maintain 6-foot distance between you and the person you are working with, then you must wear a mask.

If one of our inspectors has to work with one of your employees, closer than 6 feet, and your employee is not wearing a face covering, our employee has been instructed to terminate the inspection immediately. You will be charged for the initial inspection and any additional inspections that must take place in order to complete the inspection process. In order to prevent the possibility of exposing your employees and others to COVID-19 and to prevent additional charges, ensure that your staff have the proper face coverings and that they utilize them according to the current state mandate.
