## **Revised Fee Schedule for the Elevator Safety Act**

In accordance with North Carolina General Statutes § 95-110.5A, Commissioner Farley has established the following fee schedule effective July 8, 2025. This schedule shall remain in full force and effect until June 30, 2026, at which time the Commissioner shall adjust the fees effective July 1, 2026. Notice of all fee changes will be published in the North Carolina Register and on the NCDOL website at least 60 days prior to any adjustment.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> An expedited fee will be charged for any new or reinspection requests submitted fewer than five business days before the scheduled inspection date, as well as for inspections requested outside of normal business hours, on weekends, or on state government holidays. <sup>2</sup> In accordance with the requirements of NCGS § 95-110.5A(b), the permit application fee shall be the greater of \$200.00 or 1% of the contract price for the alteration or installation of the device being permitted. Permit applications will not be fully processed until the associated permit application fee has been submitted. Any revisions to be made to a processed permit will require a new permit application and the new contract, plans, and drawings to be resubmitted. A new invoice will be generated and credit will be given for any fees previously paid for the permit being revised.
