RE: Electrical Licenses

Greetings from the Elevator and Amusement Device Bureau. This letter is in response to several questions we receive each month regarding the requirement for an electrical license from the North Carolina Board of Electrical Examiners.

Effective January 1, 2011, per Chapter 87-43 of the NCBEEC, all companies that engage in the practice of installing, maintaining and/or modernizing elevators, wheelchair lifts, construction hoists and relating lifting equipment specifically designed to transport people, must have an electrical license to supervise the work being done. No company can use another company's electrical license to perform any work in the state of North Carolina. They must have a person on their staff with this credential.
